Alabama Possible builds educational equity through the following program areas:

Research: We annually publish the *Poverty Data Sheet*, a comprehensive graphic resource that highlights statewide poverty rates and data related to educational attainment, employment, and food security.

Engaged Learning: We promote engaged learning that combines classroom instruction with thoughtful community and civic engagement. We support relationship- building among our higher education members through statewide events including our annual *Hungry for Justice* and *Lifetime of Learning* conferences.

Poverty Simulations: We facilitate *Poverty Simulations*, which increase participants' understanding of the hardships and emotional toll experienced by low-income families. Through role-playing, participants must try to provide food, clothing, shelter and other basic needs for themselves and their "families".

College Access and Success: Our college access and success programs include the *Blueprints College Success Initiative* and *Cash for College*. Both programs promote and build educational equity for low income, minority, and first generation college-going students across the state of Alabama. Through the *Blueprints College Success Initiative*, we team students with near-peer mentors who equip them to make structured decisions about their postsecondary options and support them as they navigate the college-going process. Through *Cash for College*, we work to increase the number of students completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

The Development Manager will help execute a comprehensive fundraising strategy to expand philanthropic support that includes annual giving, corporate sponsorship, foundation and government grants, major gifts, stewardship programs, and special events.

The Development Manager will work closely with the board of directors, executive director, operations director, and program team to achieve shared development goals. S/he will report to the operations director and be directly responsible for managing the systems and structures that support our development efforts.
